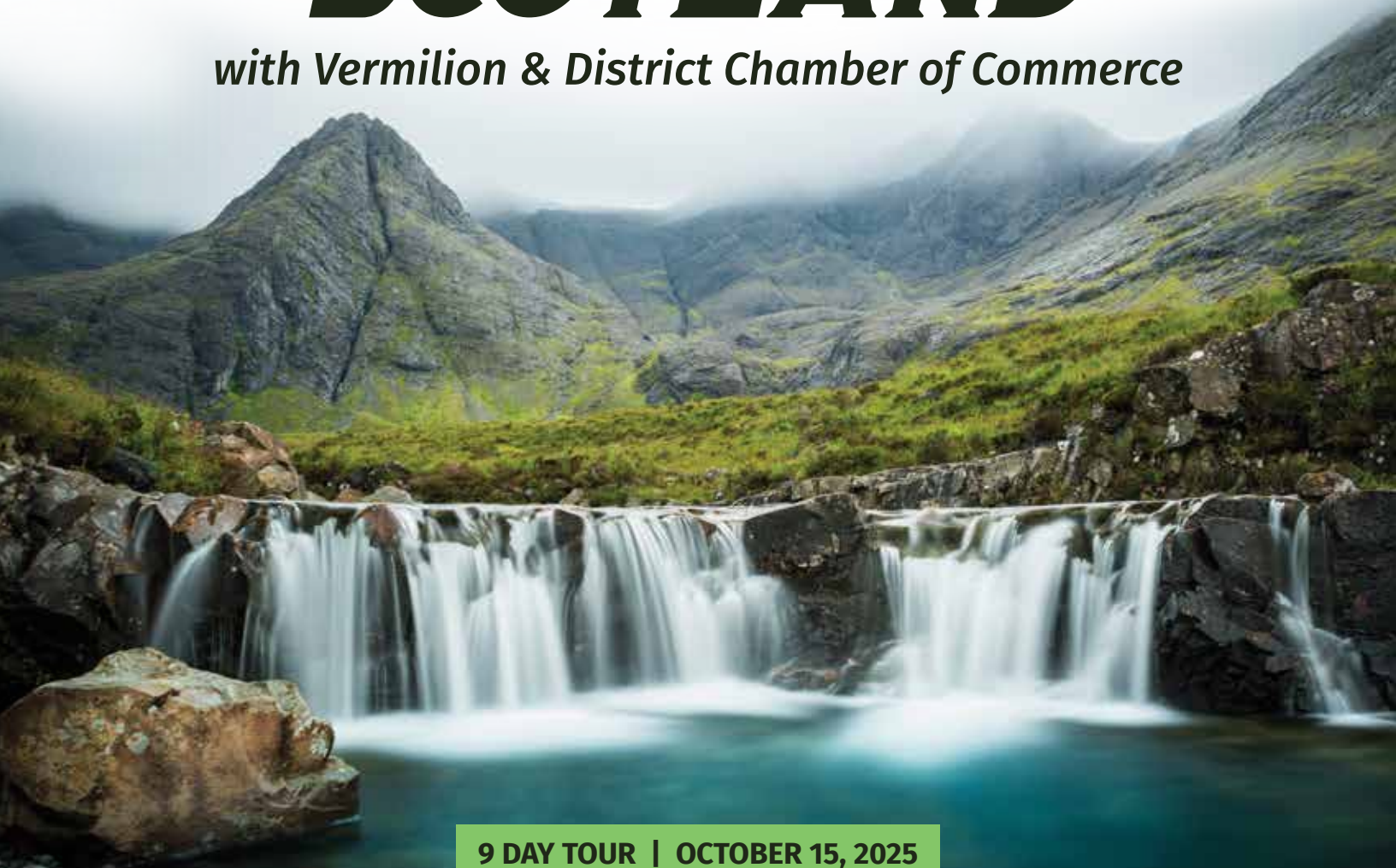

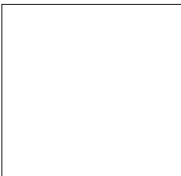

If you are ready to see some of the most breath-taking landscapes, extraordinary castles, and fascinating cities in the UK, this small group tour of Scotland is for you! Your journey will begin in Edinburgh, the Scottish capital, known for its medieval streets, ancient buildings, and bustling atmosphere. Visit Edinburgh Castle, where you will uncover thousands of years of history and take in the incredible views of the city. From there you will travel to Stirling, where you will visit the Wallace Monument, built in honor of the 13th-century hero William Wallace, and see the Blair Castle in Pitlochry before you explore Inverness, the capital of the Highlands. Visit Fort Augustus, a charming town in Northern Scotland, from where you will board your boat to Loch Ness Lake. Learn about the legend of the Loch Ness Monster as you sail along the misty waters of the lake and see if you can spot the great creature. Next, you will discover the medieval ruins of the Urquhart Castle, which was once one of the largest castles in Scotland, before you drive to Fort William, the Gateway to Ben Nevis — the highest mountain peak in the UK. Head on a stroll around Lake Lamond, one of the most popular lakes in Scotland, before you make your way to Glasgow, known for its incredible music scene and fascinating festivals and events. Your small group tour of Scotland will come to an end in this fascinating city!

TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 01: EDMONTON – EDINBURGH (-/-/-)

Today you will make your own way to your select gateway airport for your international flight to Edinburgh. Enjoy inflight meals and services. Overnight Onboard Flight

DAY 02: EDINBURGH ARRIVAL (-/-/-)

Welcome to Edinburgh! Upon arriving at the airport, you will be transferred to your hotel. You can enjoy free time to explore the area or rest and relax until your tour begins. Overnight in Edinburgh

DAY 03: EDINBURGH (B/-/-)

Spend your morning at leisure digging deep into the rich history and warm culture of Scotland. In the afternoon you will meet your local guide and set out to explore Scotland's capital city. As you explore Edinburgh you can contrast and compare the wide streets and elegant mansions of the 200-year-old Georgian "New Town" with the narrow lanes and medieval townhouses along the Royal Mile - the oldest part of the city. Head on a tour of the imposing Edinburgh Castle with its spectacular views of the city. Spend the rest of the day at leisure to explore the area, shop, or dine. Overnight in Edinburgh

DAY 04: EDINBURGH (B/-/-)

Spend the day free at leisure. Stroll through the Old Town along the Royal Mile and see the breathtaking Palace of Holyroodhouse. Soak up the city's festive atmosphere. (No coach and no guide) Overnight in Edinburgh

DAY 05: EDINBURGH - STIRLING - PITLOCHRY - INVERNESS (B/-/D)

After a delicious breakfast, you will depart Edinburgh and travel north to Stirling. Upon arrival, take some time to stroll around the historic center and take in the breathtaking views of Stirling Castle. You will also have a photo stop at the Wallace Monument, built in honor of William Wallace, a thirteenth-century Scottish military hero. From there, you will head into the Highlands, with a stop in the Victorian mountain resort of Pitlochry. After lunch (at your own expense), take some free time to explore the river-side setting. From there you will explore Blair Castle, home of the Dukes and the Earl of Atholl. Dig deep into the history of Mary, the Queen of Scots, Bonnie Prince Charlie, and how Queen Victoria's famous stay led to the formation of Europe's only private army - the Atholl

Highlanders. Your final stop of the day will be in Inverness, the welcoming capital of the Highlands. In the evening, you and your group will come together to share stories of the day's adventures over an included meal.

Overnight in Inverness

DAY 06: INVERNESS - LOCH NESS - INVERNESS (B/-/D)

This morning you will enjoy a cruise in Loch Ness where you will have the opportunity to spot Nessie! Next visit Urquhart Castle. Urquhart Castle offers a taste of the Highlands at their most dramatic. Discover 1,000 years of drama, experience a glimpse of medieval life, and enjoy stunning views over Loch Ness from the ruins of the greatest castle in the Highlands. After you will visit a local distillery. Spend the afternoon in Elgin and visit the ruins of Elgin Cathedral, one of Scotland's most beautiful medieval buildings.

Overnight in Inverness

DAY 07: INVERNESS - FORT WILLIAM - LOCH LOMOND - GLASGOW (B/-/-)

Today, depart the Highlands and head south to Glasgow. En route visit Culloden Battlefield, the scene of the 1746 Battle between the Jacobite and British armies. As the last battle being fought on British soil, Culloden marks the beginning of dismantling the structures of Highland society. Then visit the Highland Folk Museum that brings to life earlier Highland peoples' domestic and working conditions. Continue to Glasgow

DAY 08: GLASGOW (B/-/-)

Explore Glasgow on your own. (No coach and no guide)

DAY 09: GLASGOW – EDINBURGH – EDMONTON (B/-/-)

After breakfast, you will make your way to the airport in Edinburgh to board your flight back home.
